- 7.2. Discussion and possible action to approve engineering services contract with Freese and Nichols related to development of water utility master plans. (Wade Benton)

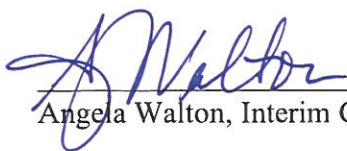
