Jeff White presented an update on the Hutto Lake Park improvements to the Board. Due to the Upper Brushy Water Easement ,various permits will be required to update and connect the trail system. No action taken

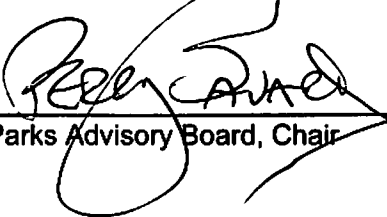
