(Note: The Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, prohibits governing bodies from fully discussion, debating, or considering subjects for which public notice has not been given on the agenda. Issues that cannot be referred to the Corporation Staff for action may be placed on the agenda of a future meeting.)
