A public hearing was opened at 7:02 pm, there being no public comment, the hearing was closed at 7:02 pm.

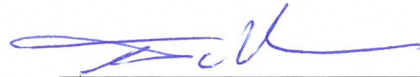
4C. Open and conduct a second and final hearing regarding the proposed City of Hutto Budget for Fiscal Year October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019

ADJOURNMENT

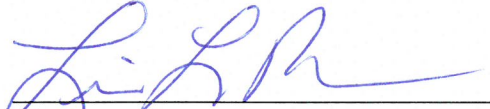
There being no further business to be heard, the meeting was adjourned at 7:03 p.m.
