RESOLUTION NO. R-2023-198

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HUTTO, TEXAS, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. R-2023-176 CALLING AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON SEPTEMBER 7, 2023, AT 7:00 PM ON THE PROPOSED NO NEW REVENUE TAX RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 AND ADOPTING RESOLUTION NO. R-2023-198 CALLING AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON SEPTEMBER 14, 2023, ON THE PROPOSED VOTER APPROVAL TAX RATE TO BE INCLUDED IN THE HEARING NOTICE; PROVIDING PROPER NOTICE & MEETING, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City of Hutto (“City”) has received the calculated effective rate information as presented by the Williamson County Appraisal District; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 26 of the Texas Tax Code requires the City Council to hold a public hearing before adopting the Tax Rate; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2023-176 approved calling and setting a public hearing on September 7, 2023, at 7:00 PM on the proposed No New Revenue Tax rate for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the City Council desires to repeal Resolution No. R-2023-176 and call and set a public hearing on September 14, 2023, on the proposed Voter Approval Tax Rate to be included in the hearing notice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUTTO, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1: The findings set forth in the recitals of this Resolution are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings of the City Council and are incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: Resolution No. R-2023-176 is hereby appealed.

Section 3: City Council hereby calls and sets a public hearing on September 14, 2023, at 7:00 PM at City Hall, 500 W. Live Oak, Hutto, Texas on the proposed Voter Approval Tax rate for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 and determining the proposed tax rate to be included in the hearing notice. The City Council will vote on the proposed tax rate and budget at a regular meeting held on September 14, 2023 at 7:00 PM at City Hall, 500 W. Live Oak, Hutto, Texas.

Section 4: The proposed tax rate for fiscal year 2023-2024 is \$0.470930. This tax rate exceeds the No New Revenue rate and will raise more taxes than last year’s tax rate.

Section 5: The city secretary is hereby authorized to cause notice of the aforementioned public hearings to be published in compliance with Texas law.

Section 6: The City Council hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Resolution and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.

Section 7: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
