Fritz Park Timeline

December 2022 - The Parks Advisory Board reviewed the master plan concept at the December 14, 2022 meeting. The board voted unanimously to approve the master plan concept.

January 2023 - The plan was presented to the Council for review.

April 2023 - The Parks Advisory Board was presented with feedback from the community on this Park design.

April 2023 - It ranked as the #1 Parks and Recreation priority at the budget workshop.

May 2023 - It ranked as the #2 project at the May budget workshop.

June 2023 - Presented as part of the City of Hutto Capital Improvement Projects 5-year plan.

July 2023 - Council approved an agreement with Burditt for Design and Construction Documents.

August 2023 - Construction Manager At Risk request for qualifications is active.
