In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act this NOTICE is hereby given that a regular Meeting of the City of Hutto Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors and the City of Hutto Community Development Corporation Board of Directors will take place at the above stated date, time and location.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

The following social distancing rules apply to the public attending this meeting:

- 1) Any member of the public attending the meeting shall maintain a six-foot distance from others (except for those who live in the same household). City Staff, Corporation Staff and City Officials shall practice social distancing to the extent able without interfering in the ability to carry out the essential government functions to be conducted at this meeting.*
- 2) Attendance in the Council Chamber will be limited to allow for the public in attendance to practice social distancing. Seating may be assigned.*
