F. *General discussion and updates regarding Perfect Game.*

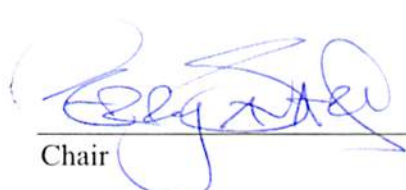
