



**PARKS ADVISORY BOARD
MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 14, 2018**

The Hutto Parks Advisory Board met in a regular meeting November 14, 2018, in the City Hall Council Chambers, 401 W. Front St., Hutto, Texas 78634.

1. CALL SESSION TO ORDER

Chairman Gaydos called the session to order at 7:00p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

6 members of the Parks Advisory Board were present. Board Member Michael Orman was absent.

Members of staff that were present were Shane Mize, Parks and Recreation Director, Scot Stromsness, Executive Director, Community Services, Cari Hodges, Management Assistant, and Daniel Roque, Management Assistant .

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were not any public comments.

4. AGENDA ITEMS

4A. Consideration and possible action on the minutes from the Parks Advisory Board regular scheduled meeting held on October 10, 2018.

MOTION: Vice Chair, Perry Savard moved to approve meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Katie Weiss, Board Member.

Motion carried with 6 ayes and 0 nays.

4B. General Discussion on Parks and Recreation Bond Election.

Director Shane Mize addressed the board that the Bond election passed with roughly 60/40 in favor of the bond. Director Mize also estimated that about 4 to 6 million dollars of the bond will be set aside for park improvement such as trails, pavilions, and the elementary fields as well as about 35 to 40 million dollars being used for the new facilities. Director Mize advised the board on many aspects of parks that need repair and possible ideas for features in the new Recreation Center/Sports Complex.

4C. Discussion and possible action on Parks Advisory Board involvement regarding parkland dedications and fees.

Director Shane Mize advised the board to vote on allowing Director Mize represent the board in the parkland dedication process. The board decided not to put this to a vote. Instead, the current process will remain the same. Items referencing parkland dedications will be placed as agenda items on future Parks Advisory Board meetings. If a decision is needed before the next PAB meeting then a special meeting will be called as long as there is a quorum.

4D. Discussion and possible action on Holmstrom Field sign replacement.

The board moved to vote on the Holmstrom Field sign replacement to a 5'x10' sign (or 4'x8' if that is the biggest sign allowed) and on location 2 with 6 votes yes and 0 votes no. Vice Chair Perry Savard motioned to approve the vote. The vote was seconded by Board Member Katie Weiss. The motion carried with 6 ayes and 0 nays.

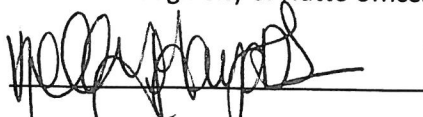
4E. Director's update on Parks and Recreation past, current and future items.

Parks and Recreation Director Shane Mize addressed the board that Thanksgiving camp had been full booked with 20 children for the teen and youth groups respectively. There will be field trips for both the teen and youth groups. Director Mize also informed the Board that the Christmas Tree Lighting planning was underway. Youth Basketball registration was extended in order to add more numbers to both the boys and girls leagues. Director Mize also informed the Board that there were about 3,000 people in attendance.
